



How We Work

At Star for Life we take advantage of our knowledge and experience from the field in fighting HIV/AIDS. We apply the following principles to all our work:

- We work where the problems exist together with young people, community members, local partners and the government in combating HIV/AIDS and stimulating socioeconomic development
- We don't see HIV/AIDS as purely a health problem, rather as a problem that is caused by and that causes poverty and inequalities. Because of this complexity, Star for Life has deployed a broad based approach, which targets both the health aspects and the socioeconomic aspects of the HIV/AIDS epidemic.

We have prioritised three areas of work where we can make the most difference: in-school programmes, VCT programmes and out-of school programmes.

The areas we work in are located both in rural and urban areas of South Africa and Namibia.
